- COVID-19 situation
 - Recent surge in MA

 - Recent cases at CBCGB, even this morning
- 3rd Month of church reopening status
 - All congregations dropped in the in-person attendance, 50-70%CM, 70-80%CB, 70%YM
 - ChM returned online till 12/12
 - Some CM fellowships returned online, and last Friday all fellowships returned online
 - YPF still remained in person on Saturday
 - Temporarily hold off food/drink service

- More efficient communication channels among congregations are in the discussion
- More cautious adjustments are needed to the new situation
- [Q]: How to deal with the shortage of coworkers during restrictions?

- Cleaning crew schedule

- Reopening protocol: needs to be deep cleaned (instead of disinfection cleaning) momentarily and remains closed for 3 days
- Incubation period is uncertain, potentially many people may have been exposed, causing plausible concern for wider spread, besides the facility cleanness

- Acceptable and Minimized risks
 - Clean the facility
 - Minimize the number of coworkers present
 - Allow only essential coworkers with no known close contacts to the identified COVID cases
 - Base on volunteering
- [Actions]:
 - Close office today (Weihsin)
 - Conduct disinfection cleaning this afternoon by the cleaning crew (Weihsin)
 - Allow essential coworkers onsite only, voluntarily and available. Otherwise, go entirely online (Josh)
 - Holy Communion
 - Advent candle lighting and Scripture reading done by onsite coworkers (P. Yuegang to inform the family)
 - Kelly to contact the worship team
 - SS online
 - CBE promotion in the Sunday afternoon follow the same suit
