

CBE status and phase (KC)

- Several design and build contractors have been contacted not a good time for this
 exercise, either due to busy season for constructions or lack of local license or retired
 businesses, which may drive up the cost, but there may still be some opportunities to
 pursue
- Promotion (on going): Preparing video and brochure, to share among fellowships

- Funding updates: \$1,264K, lower-than-expected pledge
- Taking the inputs from BOD, Pastoral Staffs and the current funding situation into consideration, a three phased CBE plan has been presented and proposed, e.g., finishing the project via various phases
