Review and Action for Christian School proposal (Juta, Patrick, Taylor, Yuguang)

- Benefit to the community and the church
- Fit for the church vision
- Practical considerations, e.g., operations, decorations, etc.
- [Consensus]:

 - Better usage of the facilities
 - Outreach to the communities appears to in line with the social concern vision
- [Considerations]:
 - Rental of a designated space/time, or coshare a space/time
 - In the long-term, sharing space would be more difficult
 - Parcel out a designated space is not easy either
 - Decorations
 - Relationships between the church and the school
 - How much impact would the church have on the policy making process of the school?
 - Shortage of coworkers to get involved
 - If partnership, running in parallel two organizations would be resources demanding such as many and long-term coworkers

CBE Status report (KC)

- Promotion
 - Draft promotion video done
 - Project promotion to be done among each large fellowship
 - Promotion brochure to be updated and mailed to each of the current and past member
- Fundraising
 - Current available CBE fund: about \$1.3m
 - Pledge and participation still lower than expected up to May
- Building plan
 - 3-phases, including
 - Children area renovation
 - Classrooms construction
 - Chapel framing and finishing
 - Multi-purpose room framing and finish
 - Parking lot renovation
 - One contractor show interest: estimated about \$5m, same in ballpark as budgeted but differ in phase, broken down as,
 - Phase 1: \$3m (\$1m more)
 - Phase 2: \$1m
 - Phase 3: \$1m (\$1m less)
 - Member loan of \$1-\$1.4m for 1-7 years may be considered. The following factors need to be considered:
 - Inflation and its compounding effect if we decided to delay the project.
 - Assumption of continued surplus from the past to pay back the member loan.
