Mission Fund Planning (Eric)

- Deficit
 - Donation rate has declined since COVID
 - Getting into deficit because of expense increase when some missionaries moving back from the mission field to high cost regions due to restricted rules for foreigners in the serving countries
 - ANM or NCNI may not be the reason directly contributed to the deficit
- Communicated with church members, preparing a letter for all
- Meet with fellowships to address questions and concerns, and provide guidance
- Identify areas for adjustments, may prioritize the fund sending for
 - CBCGB sent missionaries
 - Support for missionaries working at unreached people group
- Ask partners to prayer together
- Leverage some surplus funds from other ministries?
 - Unwritten code: honor the donors' purpose
 - Special cases: end of the year to decide the surplus, which needs CC
 - E.g., ANM, general fund
 - ANM committee has the legal stand to decide the direction of the fund
 - o [actions]:
 - ANM committee to decide the leverage from ANM fund
 - Mission committee is solely responsible for the fund either surplus or deficit
 - Inform the missionaries about the financial situation
 - Suggest to educate members to support missionaries collectively instead of individually
 - Suggest for mission committee to summarize the situation for BOE

- CBE brochure updated and printed out, to be distributed to the congregation and former CBCGB members
- Fundraising

o Pledges: \$234,140

Donation received: \$173,249Total fund so far: \$1,390K

Projection: By 10/2023: \$1,570K+\$300K capital fund

Phase I need: \$2,400K

- Phase II: \$1.52mShortfall: \$530K
- CBE plan: remain the same, same budget and design
- Pending for the written Contract from the contractor towards the end of November this year

Phase I: \$2,366KPhase II: \$1,516KPhase III: \$781K
