Opening Prayer (E. Yuguang)

Brief Sharing (E. Ruike)

- Culture: long time thinking on this topic. "What is culture?" a good definition is in need although everyone understands it but not widely acceptable. Definition quoted from "余 秋雨 的" (Qiuyu Yu's) book "何谓文化 (What is the culture)?"
- Why are we ashamed of Chinese Culture: Germany vs China? Germany started two world wars in recent history, but nobody hates Germany's music (Bach, Mozart, Beethoven, etc...), China seldom colonized any country in history, but why was Chinese Culture misread?
- China is the only one of the four oldest civilizations left, why and what is the secret?
- We need to ask ourselves: what glues us at CBCGB? What is our identity? God gave us the cultural gifts, how can we use it in gospel preaching?
- Reflection: E. KC: Chinese culture is good, mild and not aggressive, typical of eastern culture (vs western culture, aggressive). So Chinese culture seems to have less impact on the world, partially because we started late to impact. Waiting for 10-20 years we may see the difference; E. Chaw-bing: The different behavior between "知识分子" (Intellectuals) and "其他人群" (others; e.g., not so polite behavior of Chinese people in the supermarket). Majority Chinese people is not 知识分子 (intellectuals).
 - o E. Yuguang: interesting points and worthy of more discussion. 1. We have a mission to let people know the gospel; 2. Every culture has merits and short-comes, we should come together from every background and culture under the same roof- church of multicultural believers.
 - E. Chaw-bing: Christianity is self-less, we should come to Christianity from every cultural background.

BOD updates-Major activities and planning (Deacon Ye)

- Major Projects in CBCGB
 - Children Ministry (1st FL) single-entry project (security enhancement)
 - Kylie has contacted 4 construction contractors,
 - Coworkers (Kylie, Jason, Tony, Hongwei, Ye) met on(April 2nd) to share information and discuss on future steps
 - Kylie will reach out to Grace Chapel and LCA, as well as some contacts in the church security and church management Facebook groups, to see if any recommendations for contractors are available.
 - Tony and Kylie will sync up to discuss the non-negotiables and how we will present to CC when needed. Children ministry will continue to advocate that the capital fund is to be used for this project.
 - Jason will also look up different options for battery backup and fail-safe to determine which would be best, so we know what to ask the security consultant.
 - Once all of these items are complete, Kylie will follow up with contractors to see if they have any referrals to architects or if we need to find an architect to make drawings, so we can then get a better quote from the contractor, including permitting costs, etc.
 - Stewardship will keep communicating with the CBE team. Both
 projects remain flexible in terms of where the connection from the
 new building attaches to the main building. Given that both
 projects will have an impact on each other and require working
 with the city in terms of permitting and fire code
 - Action: One sister from MIT fellowship can help to make the drawing, E. KC to make the connection

 - Determined to move forward with "Yuling Designs".
 - Contract Signed by Kylie, estimated cost ~\$750,
 - Service will cover 1. branding color palette. 2. branding fonts. 3. graphic guideline PDF
- Property Maintenance & Management

They are only open Monday thru Friday 8:00am to 5:00pm so it wouldn't affect Friday nights and Sundays.
 - Incidentally their campus could act as an evacuation place for us as well. She would like a formal response from us asap.





CBE Update (E. KC)

- Pledge participation rate is still kind of low: First 16 months (from 12/18/2021 3/31/2023): Received 59 pledges total \$317,872. Total donation received in 16 months: \$305,542. Total CBE fund at the end of Mar 2023: \$1,511K
- Revised quote from Callahan/Hoffman Co, Inc.:
- Design & Build: Phase I: \$2,121K, Phase II: \$1,490K, Phase III:\$ 792K, Total: \$4,403K
 (Design & Permit: \$293K, Build: \$4,110K)
- The design and build contractor is working on the detailed drawing and engineering work for the preparation of building permit application. Communication between the contractor and Lexington Town Officials started: for the requirements of the permits

- Current funding by Mar. 2023: \$1,511 K, Projected funding by Mar. 2024: \$1,691 K, if adding \$300 K from capital fund: \$1,991 K. Phase I design and build cost: \$2,121 K, and the Shortfall will be \$130K.
- Church Building Expansion Project Updates:
 - Divide the current plan into three phases.
 - Phase one: \$2.12 mm (fundraising \$750K)
 - Multipurpose Activity Center: Indoor Gym
 - Bathrooms for multipurpose activity center
 - Bathroom fittings for the new chapel.
 - Foundation for classrooms, office and new chapel.
 - Phase two: \$1.49 mm (fundraising \$1.49 mm)
 - Complete 14 new classrooms, 4 new offices.
 - Phase Three: \$0.79 mm (fundraising \$0.79 mm)
 - Complete the New Chapel 355 seats.
 - Improve gravel parking lot
