    - Projects in the Pipeline
      - Upper parking lots gravel refill
      - Church office roof replacement
  - Property Maintenance
    - Removed an old wasp nest that penetrated the Carriage house wall and a sofa chair; separated and moved the sofa to the dumpster.
    - HVAC filters were all replaced with MERV-13 filters (x 27).
    - Fellowship's fall cleaning was cancelled this year. Office staff will get the yard cleaned up at some essential areas and have the contractor do a thorough cleaning later.
    - PPE preparation for more indoors needs in the near future.
    - Ye will ask Weihsin about logs of all repairs (Ruth did previously) as well as look into need/ability to flush water
    - Suggestion to perform regular checks to make sure everything looks OK, so no problems arise until it's too late (like mold in basement and wasp nest in Carriage House)
      - Have a checklist to document what and when to check
      - During pandemic, ask the congregation if anyone would like to join Stewardship
         Committee temporarily to help with some of the routine tasks/checks
        - Hongwei will talk to Weihsin and Jay to see if there are a list of tasks that others can help with
  - Property Management
    - Reopening for ministries and fellowships:
      - CB worship team weekly routine practice started on 9/5
      - o CM YPF's, CB core retreat meeting, Youth ministry servant team gathering.
        - More than 10 groups using indoor or outdoor venues (Thanks to Yingyuan).
    - Kola's office:
      - Eric and Jay moved library books and other unwanted stuff to other places and cleaned the room.
      - Eric put a stop sign outside of his office door which was an exit door.
    - Processed invoices, requisition forms and payments.
