- COVID-19 Emergency Response Protocol
 - For reference: (<u>https://docs.google.com/document/d/1qJBkV4L_6GGWZ8n82XTLEIU1627Tq7aQ5IUbEGBCcZ</u> <u>Y/edit</u>)
 - Background: two instances of people potentially have close contact with COVID, then the facilities need to close down
 - Guidelines created to provide response plan to close facilities and inform the congregation of the situation if someone has visited our church and is COVID-19 positive and/or suspected to be infected with COVID-19 (index case)
 - In this case, church will be closed down immediately
 - Signs will be put up to notify that the church is closed
 - CC will send out an email notifying the congregation that the church is closed
 - Contact tracing to be done by the state
 - Index case and close contacts will be encouraged to seek advice from primary care physician
 - Church will reopen if:
 - Church deep clean is completed
 - 7 days have elapsed after index case's last visit
 - Index case's COVID test result is negative
 - Hongwei motioned to approve these guidelines and Stan seconded.

Motion passed with unanimous approval for use

- Neighbor Church Support Initiative
 - Background: Came out from the discussion on how to utilize our financial surplus from God
 - Currently, we do not have a policy on donating funds to other churches
 - In general, giving has decreased due to the economic downturn
 - Goal: Express love and support to others in God's family through financial support
 - Challenge: Need to determine guidelines for which churches we will support
 - Form another committee with representation from pastoral staff, BoE, BoD, COM, etc.
 - How to fund this initiative:
 - Start with the congregation to help raise funds then match with our church surplus
 - Surplus match up to \$50K of congregation donation
 - Which churches could qualify?
 - We have more connections with Chinese churches, but this initiative could extend to any church in the Boston area
 - Suggestion: Work with other large churches in the area to identify churches in need
 - Motion: Approve this initiative to present to BOE
 - Jianglin motioned and Elbert seconded.
 - Motion passed with unanimous approval
- CBET Sharing
 - CBEAT Requirements (Round 1)
 - Gym: full-sized basketball court, storage, bathrooms, locker rooms, etc.
 - Chapel: raised stage, 350+ seats, good acoustics/ aesthetics/AC, AV room, lobby area, storage, etc.
 - Fellowship Rooms: partitions for small group spaces, reasonably sound-proof.
 - CBET Finding
 - Difficult to design a building combining gym + chapel + fellowship rooms with required

conditions (acoustics, aesthetics, sound-proofing, easy chairs setting up, etc.), based on other churches' experiences

- CBET Proposal (Round 1)
 - Gym & Fellowship Rooms: use cost-effective pre-engineered steel house for gym + associated space + fellowship/office rooms
 - Chapel: expand and renovate current chapel and surrounding area as new CB chapel and associated space
 - Connection structure: to be built between steel house and main building
- CBEAT Requirements (Round 2)
 - Spaces needed due to Chapel renovation and Carriage house demolition

- CBET Proposal (Round 2)
 - Enlarge the fellowship/office area (two-storied) of the pre-engineered steel house, to provide additional required spaces due to Chapel renovation and Carriage House demolition
 - Preliminary plan; final plan will comply with requirements
- CBEAT Requirements Chapel (Round 3)
 - Min. seating capacity of 350 inside chapel should be met (not include overflow area)
 - Speaker and audience should see each other for interactivity (so projector screens are not good enough)
 - Sufficient overflow area
 - Pulpit position at center
- CBET Proposal (Round 3) Chapel Options
 - Keep current stage orientation and box internal steel brace nicely
 - Use new stage orientation and expand half rear wall
 - Use new stage orientation, expand full rear wall and extend connection structure to allow passage to MP
- Task 1: Multi-purpose (MP) building room division
 - Spaces needed due to the Chapel renovation and carriage house demolition
