

#### BoE Sharing

- o BOE 2021 Plans and Actions
  - Reopening Task Force Planning for 2021 (Elder Ruike)
    - Mission and Strategies: care for the spiritual, physical, and mental well-being with compliance with government guidelines
    - Starting CAUTIOUS and SAFE (CBCGB Phase II) opening on March 1st
      - o Continue online serves for worship and other ministry meetings
      - Step 1: No more than 8 people in sanctuary: preacher/presider/AVs/Supports
      - Step 2: No more than 12 people in sanctuary: preacher/presider/Worship Team/AVs/Supports
      - Step 3: No more than 25 people in sanctuary: preacher/presider/Worship Team/AVs/Supports/additional congregants
      - Number of on-site support staff outside of sanctuary are not counted, will be on an as-needed basis and subject to BOD guideline limitations
    - Some groups (such as caring groups and fellowship groups) may continue to meet on campus following the BOD special event
    - People in high-risk groups are continuously encouraged to worship online for their health and safety
  - Taskforce team and procedures
    - Core taskforce team (Pastor Juta, Elders, Jeff, Head of BOD) meet weekly or biweekly
    - Regular taskforce meet once a month (all BOE, Pastor Yuegang, Minister Jeff, Samuel, Josh, and Jason) will help Ms to develop detail plans, resources and timetable. The final plan will be aligned with BOE
    - BOD creates the guidance according to federal, CDC, state, and local government guidelines and provide evaluate medical advice
    - Medical team: Make sure we compliance with federal, state, and local government guidelines, collaborate with BOD on special cases protocol/handling during each phase, such as, safety measure, protocols of Illness, emergency, advise on who should be back in later phases etc.



- How do we announce Phase II plans to the rest of the church?
  - Action: Need to share new Phase II reopening plan with the whole church community effectively
    - Elbert to work with website manager to update the CM web page with announcement
  - We can consider moving the church-wide meeting from April to March to share details regarding Phase II reopening and answer any questions from the congregation
  - Another suggestion is to summarize the Phase II reopening plan as a slide or quick bulletin

  - How do we establish more trust and transparency when communicating important issues with the rest of the church?


- Our overall offering has remained consistent from year-to-year, despite the pandemic

  - Submitted to BoE for approval


- Room reservation, participants registration, waiver forms, HVAC, etc.
- Processed invoices and payments
- Community support: coordinated with the Eagle Scout team who dedicated their time and effort to make two picnic chairs to the church on 1/31



- There are abundant leaks around the church
  - There is snow/water accumulation form tower, which then drain down into the main building
  - Rubber in tower degraded over time once weather is warmer, then it can be addressed
- Reopening planning and Preparation
  - Communion sets preparation
  - Non-contact thermometers (4 ready in church office)
  - Wall-mount temp measurement for church office (proposal)
  - Multi-person thermal camera for main building (proposal)
  - Any space that is actively used will be cleaned 2x month
    - Cleaning for any Sunday worship should be scheduled after a session, assuming there is sufficient time between large events
- Church Re-opening Logistics
  - o Phase 2 will be divided into three steps
    - Step 1: preacher/presider/AVs/supports
    - Step 2: preacher/presider/worship team/AVs/support
    - Step 3: Preacher/Presider/Worship Team/Avs/Support/additional congregations
  - o CM Phase II Step 2 will start on (3/7) and meet once a month with minimum staff on site
    - Holy Communion will be included
- Neighborhood Church Support Initiative
  - Initially, we will start as a purely financial support initiative
    - In addition, also solicit prayer requests so we can partner in prayer with the churches too
  - o BoE response is enthusiastic and can be continued in the future
  - One of the ideas we can consider is having the church match whatever the church raises
  - o Action: Please find individuals who may be interested in helping in this initiative
- Ministry Sharing: Community Outreach
  - Trying to implement more Zoom meetings for outreach/prayer
  - Proposing special topics (including mental health during the pandemic) to cover as a means to share with a wider community through Zoom
  - For church-wide presentation topics being considered
    - Will occur every few months
  - Involved in personal evangelism
    - Three individuals are encouraged to share the Gospel with their friends
    - Already three people have decided to put their faith in Christ! =)
  - Integrating more outreach infomation on the website


- Could include high-quality videos of evangelistic events
- CBET Sharing
  - Multi-purpose building
    - New design cost should be comparable to previous design

## **MP: New Dimension**




- Note: red square denotes original design
  - New proposal will be 200 ft long instead
- With this design, the ramp to Building 151 will need to be adjusted
- Amphitheater to be added between MP and sanctuary
  - BoD Suggestion: Consider adding a covered walkway between MP and sanctuary
- New walking path to be added to the back of the MP from the upper-level parking
  - There should be adequate walking paths around the MP so enable one to walk from the main building to 151
  - 20 more spots will be added to the upper-level parking lot to account for the lost parking spaces with the construction of the MP

#### First floor




- Includes gym, rooms, and offices
  - There should be enough rooms to accommodate 14 youth small groups
  - Offices included for pastoral staff could be mainly for youth pastors
- Two storage rooms
  - One for youth storage
  - Another for Gym equipment
- MP First floor has direct connection to main building 1st floor
- Second floor



- CB Chapel
  - Can accommodate more than 350 seats
  - Three to four parents can fit in the parents room
    - o **BoD Suggestion:** Too small current fishbowl room is full

- Could consider two separate parents room or remove the the AV room and expand the parents room
- AV should be moved into the sanctuary
  - Reallocate seating space to accommodate a AV platform in the back of the sanctuary
- 2nd floor door would lead to the upper-level parking
- BoD Suggestion: No coat room is required for CB. It can be repurposed for something else

# Site Plan (Topographic map)



- Most of the building is on flat ground
  - Towards the upper part, we would need to cut into the slope
- Delivery of pre-manufactured building is 4-5 months after ordering
- BoD Suggestion: Strongly consider traffic flow into the building so that it can be adequately used by different demographics (parents with strollers, children, youth, elders, etc.)
  - The goal should be to include more smooth, covered paths between main building and MP
  - These high level issues is best resolved up front
  - Consider adding representatives from different congregations/demographics to provide a better understanding of how different people would be using the new church building
- Action: Gather parents to talk with Children's ministry to determine requirements for new building/children's space to send to CBEAT
  - CBET can then determine when to implement
- Samuel closed the meeting in prayer at 12:35 PM
