 - Updates on Major Projects in Pipeline
 - Sanctuary carpet replacement
 - Fund request Jay and Ye
 - Project Description: Church Sanctuary floor carpet and Sanctuary/Chapel stage carpet are in poor condition due to the age and the usage. CC suggested installing new carpet while the church is not fully "open" during COVID-19 pandemic.
 - Both Post Road Carpet and Soriano Construction claimed that they can accommodate broadloom carpet (wall-to-wall) and carpet tile combination.
 - This project is estimated to require at least two weeks to complete, and
 Stewardship would like to start at the end of May and finish before the end of June.
 - Post Road Carpet: https://www.postroadcarpetoneacton.com
 - Sanctuary Floor (using carpet tile): \$30,000 \$35,000.
 - Sanctuary/Chapel stages: \$15,492.69.
 - We still need to add furniture moving cost about \$7,000 (\$3,500 x 2).

Total estimate is about: \$57,500.

Soriano Construction:

- The whole original project including moving furniture is: \$35,000 (using broadloom carpet).
- If use carpet tile for sanctuary floor will add \$3,000 \$5,000.
- Total estimate is about: \$40,000.
- Option 1: Use similar color of current <u>Sanctuary carpet (Salmon)</u> for Sanctuary floor and Sanctuary Stage. Chapel stage will keep the similar bluish gray color



 Option 2: Use similar carpet type/color of current <u>Lobby (carpet tile, blue/gray)</u> for Sanctuary floor; Use similar color as current Chapel stage for Sanctuary/Chapel stages



- BoD unanimously approved to move forward with Post Road Carpet to complete the project
- BoD voted to approve carpet color.
 - 10 votes for grey blue -> moving forward with this option
 - o 3 votes for salmon
- Upper/lower parking lots gravel refill
 - Fund request Jay and Hongwei

- Project Description: We will need to repave the church lower parking lot with gravel to improve parking conditions when the church re-opens. This project was previously done more than 10 years ago, and now the potholes on bare ground make it difficult for our brothers and sisters to park their vehicles, this also creates challenges for the snow removal company to plow.
- Total Cost: \$24,750
- BoD Request: Obtain additional quotes for price comparison; vote through email for approval
- Church office roof replacement (pending)
- o Property Maintenance and Management
 - Church project support carpet replacement and parking lot gravel refill
 - Preparation for church reopening
 - New CBCGB sign installation at the entrance
 - Inspection alarm, kitchen suppression, elevator, etc.
 - Landscaping and dumpster

- Ministry Sharing Adult Sunday School
 - Currently offering a wide-range of Sunday School class options
 - Old Testament, New Testament, Application-based, Discipleship, etc.
 - o Many of the teachers use the time to build fellowship with those who attend
 - Additional follow-up with individuals, especially during the pandemic
 - Online attendance has been stable this past year
 - Challenges going forward
 - Zoom meetings are convenient
 - As we reopen, unsure how this will affect attendance/teaching
 - How do we support those who are being drawn to the Sunday school teachings who live outside of this area?
- Neighbor Church Support Initiative
 - Extension to the end of July for fundraising
 - **BoD Suggestion:** 6-week for fundraising is reasonable
 - Launch the first week of June
 - When communicating this initiative to the rest of the church, we will need to clearly
 define what churches will be receiving the funds and why
 - Larger church that are working with communities impacted by COVID
 - Donate money with the specific designation to support communities impacted by COVID
 - o For smaller churches that are struggling, it's hard to identify which church is in need
 - Currently checking with two church networks
 - Haitian pastor network
 - Hispanic pastor network
 - By working with these networks, we can get a better idea which churches are in need
 - The pastoral staff is willing to work with the pastors in these networks to establish relationships
- Elder Paul closed the meeting in prayer at 12:14 PM
