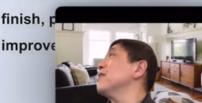
Phase III

The recently presented 3phase plan is as below

- 1. \$2.9m needed (major phase): classrooms, offices, multi-function room foundation, chapel framing, children's area renovation
- 2. \$1.1m needed: multifunctional facility.
- 3. \$1.0m needed: chapel finish, p



- Revised phase approach (Switch Order of Phase 1 and 2)
 - New Phase 1 (previous Phase 2) will probably need \$2 M to take foundation into consideration
 - Will probably kickoff end of the year
- Needs approval during September's CC meeting
- Revision for the policy Christian Educational Memorial Fund Approval Authority
 - Give the approval authority to Committee
 - BoE's review the approval
- Sending-off Pastor Jen
 - Working with Minister Taylor for a church-wide sendoff on September 4th
 - CM and CB co-workers work together
- Revision for Benefit and Personnel Policies for Pastoral and Administrative Staff is ongoing
 - Plan to submit to BoE approval next week.

 - Discussion ongoing despite rumors that it was approved

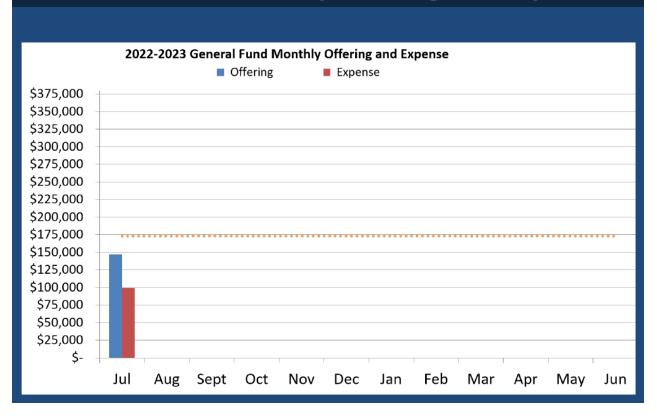

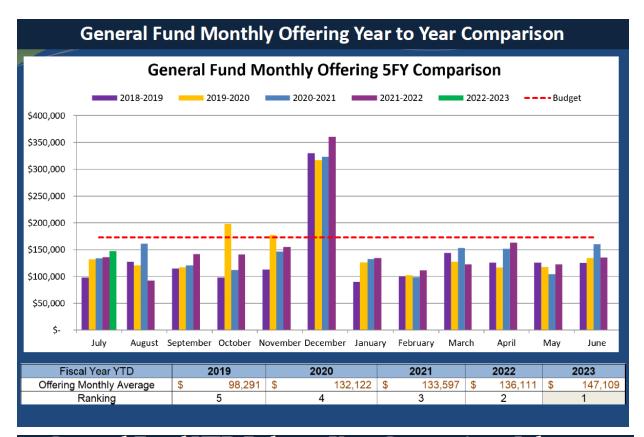

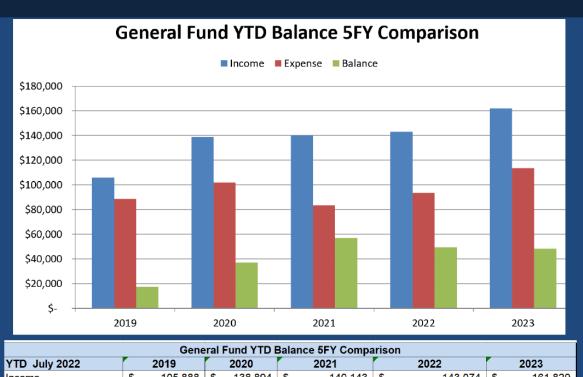

 - Mission Fund balance of \$41k, monthly spend \$38K
 - Question is whether to continue matching the \$50K that was approved previously given change in supported family
 - Will be discussed offline and bring update to the September CC Meeting
- Stewardship Report
 - Property Project Update
 - Signage Installation (Outdoor and Indoor) In Progress
 - Collecting quotes from contractors, only one response (Signarama)
 - Estimated Quote: \$4599.87
 - May have to proceed with this contractor since others are either busy or provided no response
 - Main Building elevator temporarily out of work service called, inspection in progress
 - Children Ministry (1st Floor) Security Enhancement Planning
 - Property Maintenance and Management Update
 - Parking lot striping repainting, main building, and Carriage House Complete
 - CBCGB parking and traffic task force team established Led by Deacon Jianzhong
 - Church-wide Maintenance
 - Fixed the kitchen dishwasher
 - Saved \$2,153.18 (Estimated cost)

- Sanctuary A/C thermostat Wifi connection fixed
- Working on chapel A/C root cause of malfunction has yet to be determined
- Planting flowers around church parking lot (brother Yong volunteering to help)
- Cleaning and organizing storage shed
- Fixed the broken stone walls in front of church main entrance
- Fixed the church office phone problem
- Fixed the broken water fountain in the main building basement
- Cleaned and organized closets in different rooms around the church
- Worked on mounted TV's in 151 classrooms
- Cleaned chapel kitchen drains to get rid of fruit flies
- Church Cleaning Contractors Change
 - Previous cleaning contractor resigned for summer break
 - Currently we're paying \$2,900/month
 - Requested >\$3,000/month to resume in September
 - Another cleaning contractor (Mauricio & C Services)
 - Estimated \$2900/month for just the main building
 - Church now hire a new contractor (Grace Home Services, run by sister Yuxia) which is charging to clean the whole church property for \$2800/month
- Head Deacon Confirmation Voting
 - Samuel nominates Jianglin to take over as head deacon for the remainder of the year
 - Hongwei seconds the motion
 - o Motion passed unanimously and Jianglin will take over as head deacon for the remainder of the year
- Sharing
 - Question regarding future fire drills
 - Issues with cars leaving and blocking emergency vehicles and issues picking up kids
 - Ongoing discussion already underway and a new protocol is being created
