- Minister Patrick's ordination service took place 2/11 at 1:30pm
- Pastor Jeff was sick with COVID-19 two weeks ago, has since recovered
- Ministry issues study in 2023
  - Abortion article has been finalized
  - How to care for members with special situations and needs?
    - Not just a church issue but one faced by wider society as well
  - How to reach the Younger Generation?
- Others
  - Initial meeting in February towards improving connections with sister or daughter churches (e.g., CBCGL, Nashua)
  - Positive responses from Pastor T.K. Chuang to our overtures and gifts. He also agreed to be the CM Spring Evangelistic Meeting speaker in April (small step towards reconciliation?)
    - Still some concern Pastor Chuang may not be able to speak at Evangelistic Meeting, prayer needed
- BoE Sharing
  - 2023 Ministry Reviews
    - Spiritual formation, Outreach, CM Fellowship, and COM
    - February review of CM Spiritual Formation
    - Reviews for CB and COM Spiritual Formation will be in March
    - Purpose of ministry review is for church leadership to understand the status of a ministry and its needs
  - Finance department found flaws in the tax compensation for pastoral staff
    - Need to consult with a tax expert and the financial comptroller at a neighboring church for advice how to handle the issue
  - Rental application from Willows Christian Montessori School (WCMS)
    - WCMS plans to rent room 108 in Children's Ministry as an expansion of their facility in Lexington
    - Children's Ministry agreed with the application
    - Initial trial contract will be for 2 years, annually reviewed for any violations of contract terms
    - Starting the process to draft the contract
      - Use contract example from Boston Chinese Evangelical Church as a reference
      - Contract requirements (terms) need to be reviewed by stakeholders
    - Stewardship estimates the rent could be between \$3K to \$6K per month
      - Need to understand the tax implications to the church of the rental income
  - CBE Update
    - First 14 months (from 12/18/21 2/4/23)
      - Received 53 pledges, total is \$307,772
      - Total donations received in 14 months: \$264,020
      - Total CBE fund at the end of Jan 2023: \$1,470K
      - Pledge participation rate still kind of low
    - Revised quote from Callahan/Hoffman Co, Inc.
      - Design & Build
        - Phase 1: \$2,121K
        - Phase 2: \$1,490K
        - Phase 3: \$792K
        - Total: \$4,403K (Design & Permit: \$293K, Build: \$4,110K)
    - Funding Projection for Phase 1
      - Current funding by Jan 2023: \$1,470K
      - Projected funding by Jan 2024: \$1650K


- Adding \$300K from capital fund: \$1,950K






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- Covers: medical emergency, unarmed/armed/bomb threats, fire, gas/water leak, weather, etc
