# Technology Updates

- IT Services
  - Collectively figuring out copier issues. We feel that we've encountered most types of issues at this point.
  - Setup of two new laptops
    - One for Edwin (HR)
    - One for Minister Taylor (Youth)
- AV systems
  - Work still needs to be done on copyright awareness and making resources available that are copyright friendly
  - Video scalers did not resolve front projector and chapel/video distribution blanking
  - Capital requests for microphones, in-ear monitors, and a new keyboard are still being discussed and submitted
  - Couple of cases where the recording software has crashed during service
  - Working on purchasing a second system that will address a few limitations and provide redundancy
  - Lift purchase has been put on hold until CBET has been decided since a more flexible lift could be useful depending on what we build.
- Realm Church wide management software package
  - o CB has launched the use of Realm with eGiving as the first feature
  - We've been trying to learn Realm on our own and looking how to use its features
  - We'll be working with Children's check-in so that it'll be ready when normal services resume
  - Once CB gains momentum in using Realm, we will work with COM to get them
- Security Cameras (four to be installed in children's area in the interim) ongoing
- Note: all technology/AV purchase requests need to go to <a href="itdeacon@cbcgb.org">itdeacon@cbcgb.org</a> before purchase (not just as reimbursement request) even if the money is coming from own budget

- Negative General Fund balance in Feb due to Youth Retreats
  - Will be offset in March numbers
- Start preparing budget for FY2021
  - Proposing first round of review mid-April
  - Proposing second round end of April
  - Proposing third round (if needed) in May
  - Joe and Finance Team will provide guidelines for budgeting for FY2021 given uncertainty of timelines for COVID-19
- Joe will talk with Finance Team to see if COM can start accessing online giving
- Information Session (4/5) Planning (Elder KC)
  - Will be online
  - Will address current changes due to COVID-19
  - Discussion on logistics of streaming the info session and handling Q&A
    - Ask congregation members to send questions beforehand and allow for real time questions to be asked via streaming platform
    - Presenters presenting online and will stream via vimeo
  - Moved to start time to 3pm to allow COM service to be completed beforehand
  - Dry run for presenters on April 4th (tentative)
- Feedback/Review on the Format Change of church services (All)
  - Feedback is positive so far
  - Seems that there is higher amount of caring among members

- This is still a temporary arrangement as there is still a need for in-person contact and corporate worship
- Difficult for newcomers to feel welcomed
- CM Sunday School
  - 3 classes have cancelled due to low attendance
  - Remaining classes continue to operate online
- Discussion around mental health issues during this time
  - Pastor Juta will look into material to address this issue
- Pastor Juta's thoughts
  - Remind congregation that daily devotional materials are available
  - Encourage congregation to read the Bible more
  - We should continue to spend more time (virtually) with other fellowship members
- Pastor Steve encouraging members to join weekly prayer meeting
- Suggestion for a platform to communicate questions during this time
