- CBCGB Church Calendar 2021 (Minister Taylor)
  - Certain events cancelled due to the pandemic

- CBCGB Ministry Matrix 2021 (Deacon Stan)
  - Reminder to all Church Council members to fill in 2021 Ministries
- o CBCGB COVID-19 Partner Support Initiative (Elder Ji-yong)
  - Mission Committee and Social Concerns Committee discussed the fund distribution in three scenarios:
    - Total funds of \$50K, \$75K, or \$100K
  - Mission Committee and Social Concerns Committee agreed to split the total fund evenly between the committees
  - BOE recommends to use a total of \$75K from church general fund surplus to support Mission and Social Concern partners
    - Rationale is balancing responsibility for congregation's donations and helping organizations in need
  - After discussion, more than 50% of CC prefer to use total of \$100K instead of \$75K
    - Would like to have missionaries and organizations let us know how they are using the funds
  - Elder Ji-yong motioned to approve the use of a total of \$100K from church general fund surplus to support Mission and Social Concern partners
    - Elder Chaw-Bing seconded the motion
    - The motion passed unanimously to approve the use of a total of \$100K from church general fund surplus to support Mission and Social Concern partners
  - Pastor Pan suggests making the announcement to the congregation
    - Chris will record a message and will be Chinese subtitled

- CBEAT Requirements (1st round)
  - Gym: full-sized basketball court, storage, bathrooms, locker rooms, etc.
  - Chapel: raised stage, 350+ seats, good acoustics/aesthetics/AC, AV room, lobby area, storage, etc.
  - Fellowship Rooms: partitions for small group spaces, reasonably sound-proof.
- CBET Findings:
  - Difficult to design a building combining gym + chapel + fellowship rooms with required conditions (acoustics, aesthetics, sound-proofing, easy chairs setting up, etc.), based on other churches' experiences
- CBET Proposal (1st round):
  - Gym & Fellowship Rooms: use cost-effective *pre-engineered steel house* for gym + associated spaced + fellowship/office rooms
  - Chapel: expand and renovate current chapel and surrounding area as new CB chapel and associated space

- Connection structure: to be built between steel house and main building
- CBEAT Requirements (2nd round):
  - Spaces needed due to Chapel renovation and Carriage House demolition (Friday & Sunday)

- CBET Proposal (2nd round)
  - Enlarge the fellowship/office area (two-storied) of the pre-engineered steel house, to provide additional required spaces due to Chapel renovation and Carriage House demolition.
  - Preliminary plan; final plan will comply with requirements
- Reviewed floor plans for first floor, second floor, and Chapel
- Why Do We Need CBE Project
  - Community Evangelism: Host large music/concert or sports events to attract seeker in the community to spread gospel.
  - Expand current facility capacity for seekers.
    - If CB moves to an expanded chapel
      - CM can move to two worship services adding more seats to seekers
      - CB will have a more intimate worship space for their size while still having room for growth.
  - Facilities are needed to support youth and children ministry which do not currently have sufficient space for large group activities and small group meeting spaces.
  - The current building was designed and built more than 30 years ago. This expansion
    provides opportunities to rethink how to reorganize the children's area (Mustard Seed
    and Elementary) to provide a single point of access for improving security and traffic
    flow.
  - Today's investment is for future generations. Just like what we have done 30 years ago.
  - Why now? Because the pandemic has given us an opportunity to do construction while much of our ministry is online.
- CBE Multi-purpose Facility/Chapel Project Budget/Funding
  - Current CBE funding (Nov. 2020): \$368,870
  - Current Capital Fund (Nov. 2020): \$927,283
    - Transfer 90% (\$834,555) to CBE Fund
  - Rough Estimate for the Project: \$3M which is only 60% of the cost (\$5M) for the CBE Phase II, III projects proposed previously
  - Total Fundraising Target: \$1.8M

- If cash donations cannot reach the target in a year, the rest can be raised by no-interest member loans which can be paid back within two or three years.
