 - c. Many families have left CBCGB because of lack of children facilities
 - 2. Lobby is crowded between services
 - a. Hard to continue coming if you're a newcomer and have to navigate the lobby to find the sanctuary entrance
 - b. Possible solutions are to expand lobby or have multiple entrances
 - 3. Parking is crowded and busy
 - a. Reliant on Stride-Rite parking lot
 - b. Misuse of visitors parking spaces
 - c. Traffic flow is not optimized
 - d. Possible solution is multiple entrances and exits
 - iii. CBE Status
 - 1. Phase 1 completed:
 - a. 151 (mission house) rebuild completed
 - b. Upper Parking Lot
 - c. Paved Driveway
 - d. Connection to 151
 - e. Stairway from Parking Lot
 - 2. Phase 2 and 3
 - a. Expand Sunday worship capacity for both CM and EM
 - i. New chapel, foyer, and parking lot will allow simultaneous CM and EM worship services
 - b. Improve Sunday second floor lobby congestion outside the existing sanctuary entrance
 - i. New building entrance and foyer on the first floor outside the new chapel entrance



- d. Once the design proposal is reviewed and accepted by the church leaders, this design proposal will be used to hire a professional design/building company for detail design and construction.

- 2. Binder of information
 - a. Request congregation attend future training
- f. Question & Discussion (Elder KC)
 - i. Question: How is funding for church expansion going?
 - 1. Answer: Back in 2012, there was a plan for three phases.
 - a. Phase 1 is completed.
 - b. Phase 2 and 3 are being planned on.
 - c. \$5 million was budgeted for Phase 2 and 3, financed by member loans.
 - d. Now 5 or 6 years later, we have \$500K or \$600K cash available towards Phase 2 and 3 and then will use member loans for the rest of the funds as needed.
 - e. We estimate 10 years or 15 years for length of member loans. Estimated \$300K/\$400k a year are needed for member loan repayment.
 - f. We're comfortable with the finance situation.
 - 2. Main issue is figuring out how to scope and design Phase 2 and Phase 3.
 - 3. CBET-AT an important part of listening to all member's thoughts and suggestions
 - ii. Question: How long will it be before CBET-AT hands out the survey?
 - 1. Answer: Currently creating survey, within 1 month, survey will be ready for congregation
 - 2. CC first to answer survey, and then will be sent out to ministry leaders for their members to respond
