- a. Meeting started at 9:01 am. Elder KC Chu opened in prayer.
- b. Free Sharing (All)
 - i. Deacons shared prayer requests and spent some time praying for each other
- c. Pastoral Sharing and Update (Pastor Caleb Chang)
 - i. Calendar Highlights/Changes
 - 1. 4/15: Clay Music conference well attended. Joint follow-up with MGM

 - ii. Senior Pastor Transition Plan
 - 1. Pastor Juta Pan confirmed as next Senior Pastor
 - 2. Pastor Juta Pan currently on sabbatical and will be back in September. Since Pastor Caleb Chang will be here until January, there is a 4 month overlap for smooth transition

- f. Stewardship update (Joe Ma)
 - i. Property projects
 - 1. Lighting Issues to be resolved shortly:
 - a. 8 lights at upper parking lot to be installed shortly
 - b. Replace middle light in driveway to upper level parking
 - c. Main entrance driveway lights are not working \rightarrow will repair shortly
 - 2. Driveway/Parking Lot Issues to be resolved shortly:
 - a. Potholes and cracks to be repaired
 - b. Patches in parking lot near Carriage House to be paved
 - c. Walkway at end of wooden bridge near playground to be paved

- d. Curb at the west side of sanctuary to be paved to solve ground water leakage problem
- 3. Projects in the pipeline (longer-term)
 - a. Replace wooden bridge near playground (per inspector's recommendation)
